

3rd call for proposals: Risk assessment

The third (last) grant call focuses on risk assessment, addressing the risks arising when endocrine disruptors are processed through ecosystems to cause human and animal exposure. Pertinent questions include the risks to human and animal health and the impact on biodiversity. Risk assessment should help establish measures for the protection of humans and the environment. The NRP aims to create a consensus platform for industry and regulators and to define a set of rules for future developments of more environmentally benign substances.
